
CIRCULAR

In terms of Rule 18(1)(ii) of CCS (Conduct) Rules, 1964, every Government servant belonging to any service or holding any post included in Group 'A' and Group 'B' shall submit an annual return in such form as may be prescribed by the Government in this regard giving full particulars regarding the immovable property inherited by him or owned or acquired by him or held by him on lease or mortgage either in his own name or in the name of any member of his family or in the name of any other person.

2. Accordingly, all the officers of IES Cadre are requested to submit their IPRs, in requisite format (copy enclosed), for the year 2018 (as on 31/12/2018) to the Vigilance Section, Department of Economic Affairs, **latest by 31st January, 2019.**

3. It is also informed that non-submission of IPR within the stipulated date would invite the denial of vigilance clearance for empanelment, deputation and applying to sensitive posts and assignment to training programme (except mandatory training) as the IPR status needs to be checked for the said purpose(s).


