

2. **Participation in the mid-career training programme by the above-mentioned nominated officers is compulsory.** Hence, the nominated officers may be relieved to enable them to attend the training programme from 8th September –18th October, 2014. The cost of the training programme (including the cost on account of international travel, accommodation and foreign daily allowance for the two-week overseas component) would be borne by the IIM, Lucknow. However, only TA/DA of the nominated officers, as applicable, for to and fro travel to the IIML Campus is required to be borne by the respective Ministry/Department/Organization.

3. It is mentioned that the mid-career training program comes with a lot of effort on our part as well as cost to the Government. It also entails advance planning in terms of tying up with foreign/domestic partner institutions and faculty resources, apart from handling the logistics connected to foreign visits etc. Hence, it is requested that the nominated officers may be relieved in time so as to avoid last minute cancellations which would cause loss to the Government exchequer and raise audit objections.
