Guidelines approved for the Courses at Lee Kuan Yew School of Public Policy, National University of Singapore

i) Minimum Service:

Officers should have completed a **minimum of 5 years of service** for application for One year Master in Public Administration (MPA) program and **minimum 12 years of service** for application for One year Master in Public Management (MPM) program.

ii) Number of years of Service left after the Training cum Exposure visit:

The officer should be left with a minimum of three years of service after completion of the training course.

iii) Cooling off:

(a) The officer having attended up to 2 weeks of Foreign Training sponsored by the IES Cadre are required to complete cooling off period of at least one year.

(b) The officers having attended foreign trainings/seminars/workshops of more than 2 weeks of duration are required to complete a cooling off period of one year.

iv) Number of Trainings

The officers can attend a maximum of only two Foreign Training programmes sponsored by the IES Cadre in a span of 3 years.

v) Departmental proceedings

The officer should not have any departmental proceedings/Vigilance cases pending or contemplated against him/her.
