International Growth Centre (IGC) is organizing a Summer School in Development Economics from 9-13 July, 2016 at Indian Statistical Institute (ISI), New Delhi.

2. Participants will be enrolled in one of the two tracks: **Macro and Micro**.
  - **Macro track** will cover topics like business cycle models, empirical estimation and computational methods, volatility of capital flows, currency and banking crisis in emerging economies and application of these theories to Indian data and policy experiences.
  - **Micro track** will have topics including implementing randomized Controlled Trials (RCTs), RCTs and their application of education and advances in empirical political economy and governance issues.
  
3. The basic idea is to familiarize the participants with state-of-the-art empirical methods which they find useful in their policy work. It is mentioned that the **nominees need to have a strong background in empirical methods to benefit from this course**.
