OFFICE MEMORANDUM

Subject: Mid-Career Training Programme Phase II (MCTP-II) for IES Officers with IIM-Bengaluru.

The IES Cadre Division intends to organize mandatory Mid-Career Training Program (MCTP) Phase-II for IES Officers at IIM- Bengaluru from 7th May – 4th June 2017. The duration of the training programme shall be four weeks, comprising three weeks of Domestic Learning Component (7th May – 25th May, 2017) and one week of Overseas Learning Component (28th May – 4th June 2017).

2. The above mentioned MCTP Phase-II is for Officers from up to 2006 Batch who could not attend MCTP in the previous years. Accordingly, a list of the Officers is enclosed.

3. The entire cost of the training (including the cost on account of international travel, accommodation and foreign daily allowance) will be borne by the IES Cadre Division, Department of Economic Affairs. However, only TA/DA of the nominated officers, as applicable, for to and fro travel to Delhi Airport; and for air travel from Delhi to Bengaluru and back is required to be borne by the respective Ministry/Department/Organization.

4. It may be noted that the MCTP is a mandatory programme for IES officers, as per DoPT guidelines. Further, it entails detailed and advance planning by the Cadre authorities in terms of tying up with partner institutions and faculty resources etc and also involves considerable financial commitments. Hence, timely relieving of the officers nominated for attending MCTP by the respective Ministries/Departments/Organizations is essential. The Administrative Ministries/Departments/Organizations are, therefore, requested to ensure that the officers are relieved in time, without fail.

5. It is requested that since the above programme is a mandatory course for all the nominated IES officers, confirmation of the officers as per list attached, posted in your Ministry/Department/Organization, regarding participation in the above programme, may be conveyed to the undersigned (Room No. 251, North Block, New Delhi, Telefax: 91-11-23093570), latest by 10th April, 2017.
